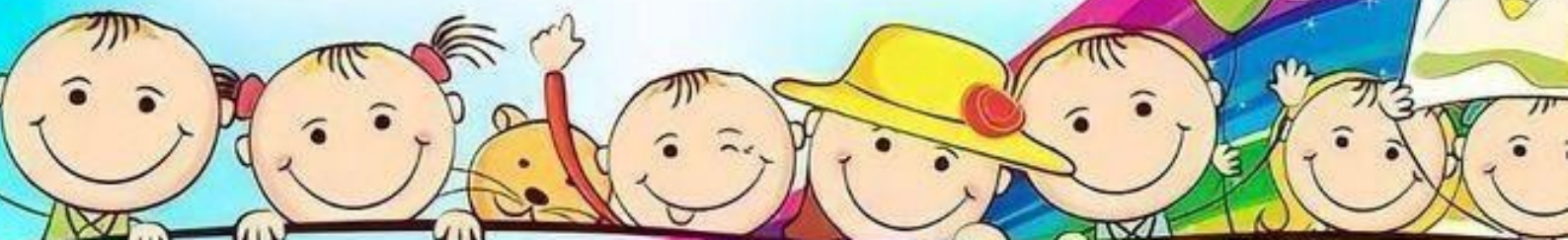

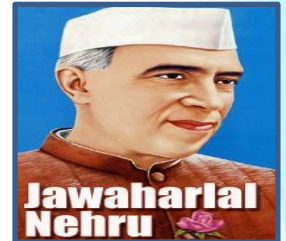
• **Simple Sentences**

WRITING SKILLS (with pencil)

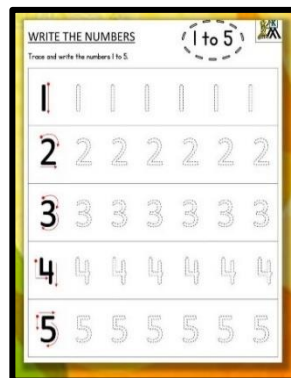
- Integrated Activity Book - Page no. 47 to 52

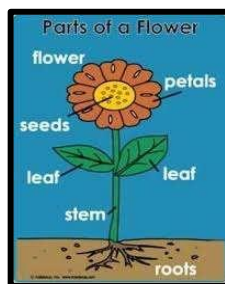
- Writing of numbers 1 to 5
