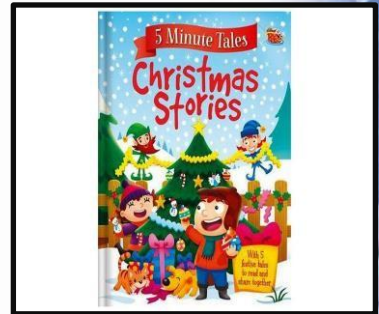

- Children will be encouraged to speak/ recite the letter song from a to z

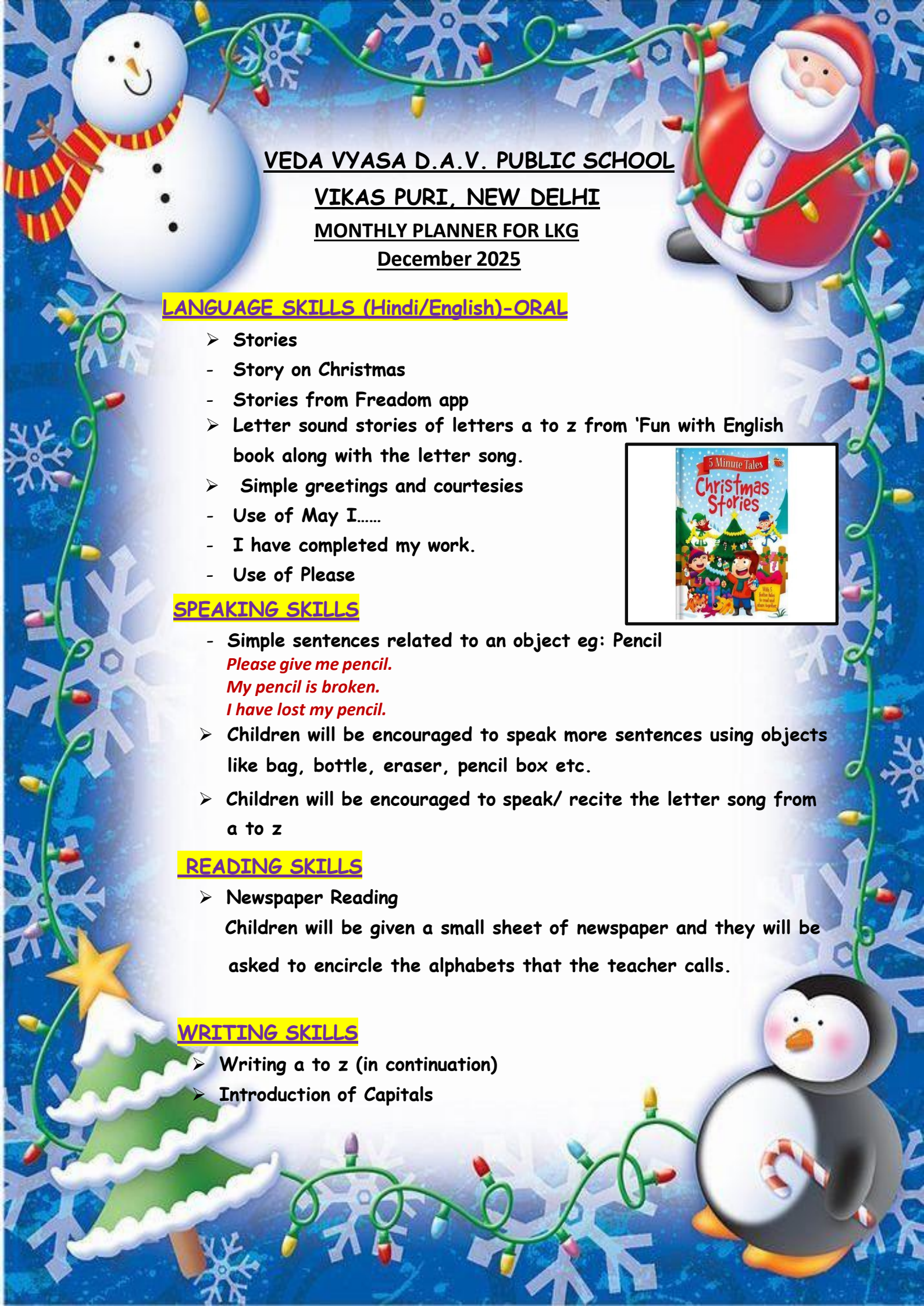
**READING SKILLS**

- Introduction of Capitals







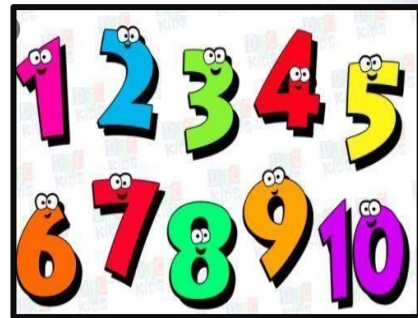

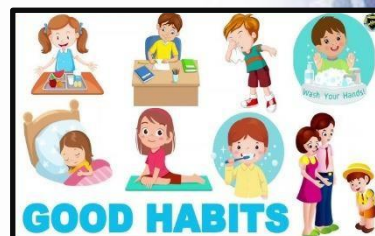
