Language Skills English

A. Listening and speaking skills

- Simple greetings and courtesies.
- Usage of courteous, polite and refined Language.

(For Eg: Excuse me..., May I borrow..., Thank you for sharing.)

- With the help of the word box, each child will be encouraged to pick up word of a,e,i,o,u vowel alongwith the cards of words like and, is, this, that, in, on, under, has. They will be encouraged to speak out the phrases using these words.

❖ ACTIVITIES


- ✓ **Full House Activity-** Each child will be given Cards containing 8 mix vowel words (a,e,i,o,u) Using the master card, the teacher will call out the words one by one. The children will circle the words called by the teacher. The child whose all 8 words get circled first will declare- FULL HOUSE and will be the winner of the activity

- ✓ **When I went out**

Teacher will tell children to close eyes and imagine to think. She will ask one student to tell what did he/she see when I went out. Then she will ask one child to start speaking When I went out I saw a tree, the next child could add into this saying when I went out I saw a tree and a bird, the third will add tree, bird and star. So, they got to know where and how to use 'and' using the nature words.

- ✓ Children will listen and speak sentences using primary words like: - and, is, this, that, in, on, under.
- ✓ Rhyming words -The teacher will motivate the children to think and speak rhyming words of e.g sun, fun, run.
- ✓ Be quick game eg. sun, bun, run etc.
- ✓ Object Speaking- Show 'n' Tell (speaking 4-5 lines on an object)

B. Reading Skills

1. Enhancing vocabulary list by reading Nature Words like rain, clouds, trees, hills, sun, river etc.
 2. Identification of reading of mix vowel words (a,e,i,o,u) from smart board.

3. Reading of simple story books.

4. Word wall of sight words, For eg: - is, and, duck table, chair, ball, doll, hill, etc.

5. Reading vocabulary list by sight- days of the week, names of colours like red, green, blue, black.

C. Writing Skills

1. Recapitulation of mix vowel (a,e,i,o,u) words and phrases in their notebook.

2. Children will be encouraged to write phrases & sentences using 'and', 'is', 'this', 'that', 'in', 'on', 'under', 'has' in book and notebook.

3. Listen and write activity-children will listen to mix vowel words and write them in the notebook.

4. Write 5 lines on any object in the notebook.

A. Listening and Speaking Skills

- पिक्चर टॉक: चार्ट्स/कार्ड किट का उपयोग करके, बच्चों को चित्र कार्ड दिए जाएंगे और वे जो देखते हैं उस पर हिंदी में पंक्तियां बोलने के लिए प्रेरित किया जाएगा।
- शब्दकोष: बच्चों को बोर्ड से दो, तीन, चार अक्षर और आ मात्रा के शब्द चुनने और उनका उपयोग करके वाक्य बनाने के लिए प्रोत्साहित किया जाएगा।

उदाहरण

पनघट – पनघट पर चल।

उपवन – मदन उपवन तक चल।

पाठशाला – आकाश नाव पर पाठशाला जा।

E. Writing skills

- बच्चे अपनी नोटबुक में चार अक्षर और आ की मात्रा के शब्द लिखेंगे।
- बच्चों को चार अक्षर और आ की मात्रा के शब्द के साथ वाक्य बनाने के लिए प्रोत्साहित किया जाएगा जैसे: कमल, मटर, नाव, आशा, पाठशाला।

COGNITIVE SKILLS

❖ Number concept

- Writing numerals from (1-50).
- Addition and Subtraction (1-20) Horizontally and vertically using number line in the notebook.
- The concept of Ones & Tens will be taught using child craft kit.
- Concepts of Ones & Tens using Kindergarten Mathematics & homemade learning aid
- Full house game will be played.
- Writing number names 1-10 in the notebook.

Environmental concepts

- Children will be introduced with seasons, light, and air.
- Children will be introduced to the concept of light & shadow.
 - ✓ To know that sun is a source of light.
 - ✓ To know that light makes shadow.
 - ✓ To understand that solid opaque objects cast darker shadows than the transparent objects

- Children will be introduced with different seasons and will be made to identify things we wear, food we eat, drink and use in different seasons.

CREATIVE AND EXPRESSIVE ART


1. Art and Craft
